Dear Friends.

This week has been a bit rough, has it not? With power outages, SNOW, the frigid cold, the problems at Boonton High School now impacting almost everyone with school-age children, I'd be surprised if we weren't all simply in survival mode.



Against that backdrop, we remain cheerfully active. Outside of our regular business dealings and doings the school this week hosted Dr. Vigen Guroian for a wonderful lecture on children's literature and the moral imagination, and our confirmation candidates attended their retreat in preparation for this April's event. Thank you for your prayers and the support of your love. Our little team here, including Father Przemek and yours truly, are thankful for your kindness!

Trying to be a good steward of what has been entrusted to me – our two beloved Boonton churches, OLMC School, and our two cemeteries – sometimes appears overwhelming to me. This is something of an ongoing spiritual battle – let me explain: I'm almost constantly confronted with a sense of things being out of my reach, out of control. We're all bound to have this experience, I think, but what we do with it matters. One of the things I do with this impulse is I launch into overdrive, believing that working harder and longer will save us. Another way I have responded to this impulse recently is to distract myself from it with something or other on the phone.

But here's the reality – here's where the spiritual battle is won: I am NOT in control, and almost everything is out of my reach. Think about my life's work – loving people into relationship with Christ – and how far beyond my reach that truly is! I'm not in control, even of my own life. But that's okay, because God is in control. It's mine, straightforwardly albeit with some difficulty, to entrust myself to him, to abandon myself to him, to cleave to him. This is where I find my peace, peace enough to keep at the impossible task before me!

Before I run off again, I wanted to share with you some great news. Due to the very generous gift of the Bogdan family, we have new hymnals for Saints Cyril & Methodius. What a great support for our worship these new hymnals are, and what a great sign of love for our parish and the good work God is doing in Boonton! Inspired by God's love for us, let's continue to join him on mission, sharing generously of what he has given us *for his mission* – our time, talent, and treasure.
