“Pragnę, aby Święto Miłosierdzia było ucieczką i schronieniem dla wszystkich dusz, a szczególnie dla biednych grzeszników. (...), wylewam całe morze łask na dusze, które zbliżą się do źródła miłosierdzia mojego.” (Dz. 699)



Koronkę do Miłosierdzia Bożego podyktował Pan Jezus siostrze Faustynie w Wilnie 13-14 września 1935 roku jako modlitwę o uproszenie łaski miłosierdzia Bożego dla grzeszników. „Przez nią uprosisz wszystko, jeżeli to, o co prosisz, będzie zgodne z moją wolą” (Dz. 1731).

As part of the Diocese of Paterson's 80th anniversary and in celebration of the reopening of St. John's Cathedral, a solo organ recital will be given by internationally acclaimed recitalist Stephen Tharp.
