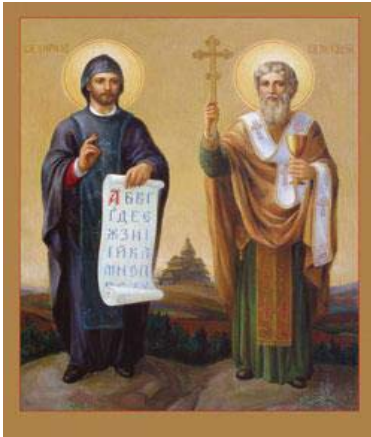

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

“Jesus took Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray. While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white. And behold, two men were conversing with him, Moses and Elijah, who appeared in glory and spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem... As they were about to depart from him, Peter said to Jesus, ‘Master, it is good that we are here.’”

How privileged for us to join the three apostles and two prophets, on that holy mountain. Peter spoke for us, and the father spoke for His Son. Moses and Elijah represented the Old Testament, the law and the prophets, and Jesus brings what was spoken to fulfillment. 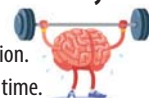

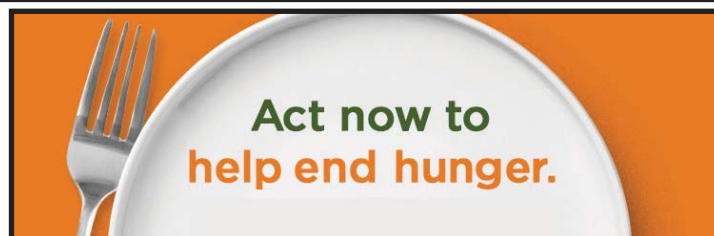
